## ART INTERACT: A MASTERCLASS IN FILIPINO ARTISTRY

Shell NSAC has always strived to ignite a passion for the arts among Filipinos. A legacy built on competition and advocacy, it has opened doors into the art world for aspiring artists and the curious masses alike.

But beyond just making art more accessible, Shell NSAC has also aimed to foster talent and creativity through Art Interact: enriching workshops and seminars that allow students to engage with and learn from veteran artists.

For its 55th run, NSAC brought back face-to-face Art Interact workshops. Held in popular art and culture centers in Metro Manila (Anima Art Space), Bacolod (Orange Project), and Cebu (The Kabilin Center), it offered free admission to those interested in sharpening their pencil sketching and sculpting skills.

Complementing the on-ground workshops was the three-part Virtual Art Interact series, which tackled digital innovations, multimedia and crypto art, Philippine folklore as a source of inspiration, and how to make a living through your artistic practice. With the sessions conducted online, artists from all over the country were able to participate and were even invited to showcase their artworks for coaching opportunities.

Both the face-to-face and virtual Art Interact legs were led by renowned artists and masters of their craft. Many came from NSAC's roster of past winners, such as Leeroy New, Jopet Arias, Rovi Salegumba, and Nestor Olarte Vinluan.
