

THE 57TH SHELL NATIONAL STUDENTS' ART COMPETITION (NSAC)

FAQs

Q: Until when can I submit my entry?

A: September 25, 2024 (11:59 PM PHT)

Q: Who is eligible to join the competition

A: The contest is open to college students who are currently enrolled for at least one semester in a duly recognized college or university in the Philippines for the academic year 2023 to 2024 and 2024 to 2025 with at least 9 units.

Graduates of the academic year 2023 to 2024 are eligible to join the contest, as long as they are enrolled upon submission of entries.

Q: I am a 1st place winner from last year's NSAC. Can I participate in the competition?

A: Yes, you can still participate but not join in the category you have already won. For 2nd & 3rd placers, you can still join the category you have been part of.

Q: What are the categories that I can participate in?

A: We currently have five (5) categories and these are

- Oil/Acrylic
- Watercolor
- Sculpture
- Digital Fine Arts
- Photography

Q: What are the requirements needed before submitting my entry for Oil & Acrylic, Watercolor, Sculpture?

A:

- One (1) full shot of the artwork including the frame with a plain background.
- Additional requirement for Sculpture: Full shot of front, side, and back
- One (1) full shot of the finished artwork with the student artist
- One (1) supporting document: Certificate of Registration; School Identification Card; Report Card; Endorsement Letter from the University signed by the Head of Department.

*NOTE: Maximum of 4MB per file upload.

Q: What are the requirements needed before submitting my entry for Digital Fine Arts

A:

- One (1) .JPG file of the artwork. Entries should be at least 300 DPI.
- One (1) original working file or layered file used in composing the entry.
- One (1) supporting document: Certificate of Registration; School Identification Card; Report Card; Endorsement Letter from the University signed by the Head of Department.

*NOTE: Maximum of 4MB per file upload.

Q: What are the requirements needed before submitting my entry for Photography

A:

- File Size: 3 to 10 mb
- Image Size: 10 x 15 inches
- Resolution: 300 dpi
- Color Profile: RGB
- Top 25 Finalists will be required to submit a copy of the original/unedited jpeg files for final evaluation.
- One (1) supporting document: Certificate of Registration; School Identification Card; Report Card; Endorsement Letter from the University signed by the Head of Department.

Q: I am selected as one of the finalists and I'm from NCR where do I ship my entry

A: Please send your artwork at 5 Axis Road, Brgy. Kalawaan, Pasig City from October 7 - October 25, 2024. The warehouse is open every Monday to Saturday, from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. The participants should cover the shipping expenses and will not be refunded.
